When children have reached the end of our reading scheme, the reading books which children take home are organised into sets according to their level of challenge, and are starred to indicate either an entry level book, or a book with a greater level of challenge. We encourage all of our readers to select texts which will both challenge and inspire them as readers, and we therefore possess collections of greater depth texts for those children who require an extra challenge.
